Beyond YESTERDAY'S WAYS

orty years are sufficient to the formation of habits.

And habits are nothing more than repeated behavior. Repetition builds character, and character is nothing more than behavior when no one is looking. The all-too-human impulse to cut a corner, to compromise a principle usually comes behind a closed door.

Cobalt associate Todd Borton works in a small office, the door almost always shut. He doodles there. He draws long, smooth lines leading, for the moment, off toward nowhere. He draws convergences, little lines that combine and don't seem to matter much. Not much at all. Except, for the moment, to the habitual Todd Borton, Designer.

For 40 years Cobalt has been building boats that go down to the sea with an intuitive grace, with a sense of style that transcends mere form, an insistence that looking good means doing good. With a four-decades' belief that absolutes include precious few exceptions. That the slow disappearance of three accent lines into an ocean of white fiberglass on a sternward gunwale somehow matters. Matters very much indeed. Because once seen, those idealized lines, that bottomless glass – or the absence thereof – cannot be unseen.

Habits harden. Bedrock doesn't bend. And so for 40 years Cobalt has operated on the corporate principles of individual skill, individual responsibility, and the peculiarly individual rewards to be found in the purposeful redrawing of a doodle. And while the company's time-honored motto - "Compromise nothing." - asks for an unchanging allegiance to integrity, intelligence, and craftsmanship, it finds its fullest expression in the expanding hearts, the everchanging minds of the people who build these boats. The Cobalt associates who came to work this morning are not the women and men who walked through here yesterday. Alive to the possibility of at long last a perfect runabout, an absolutely flawless performance cruiser going out the big, big southwest wide-open overhead door of their place of business, they have other ideas. Secure in their experience, content to again be spending the day with hometown folks known since childhood, the people of Cobalt know their

jobs inside out. And no better place, the inside, to make things better.

Forget the roundabout glamour, the showroom shine of a new model year, and look here. Right here where the tenthousandth swipe of a polishing rag reflects a four o'clock smile from a hull rubbed to a baby's bottom. Here where the strokes of a seamstress' needle sew most certainly straighter than yesterday's seams. Here where mounting screws are given an extra quarter-turn because a 30-year Cobalt veteran likes them "oilfield tight." And there, behind that door, where a softspoken, deliberate man with a flair for the dramatic is scribbling again this afternoon.

Across four decades of boat-building, amid the landlocked grasslands of southeastern Kansas, some maritime truths have come clear.

Beyond THE CONCEPTION

espite Mr. Wayne Rhodes' well-earned confidence in his colleague's abilities, Cobalt research and new-product development begins and ends in practicality. Magic word, "practical." In the Cobalt lexicon, it denotes functionality, of course, but also convenience and comfort and accessibility and dependability. And style. Elegant, refined, distinctive, very functional style. Practicality concerns itself with ultimate value.

Having listened to current Cobalt owners, having learned from knowledgeable boaters how great watercraft might be made greater still, the discovery process begins with hand tools and building materials. As opposed to a computer screen or a set of predetermined specifications. In its hour-to-hour construction a prototype takes shape. In the practicality of actually building the new boat, its strengths emerge, its opportunities for immediate improvement shout out loud.

Operating happily in reverse gear, Cobalt R&D defines the new boat on the shopfloor long before any CAD drawings might.


Another industry first was the added protection of a solid stair less steel bow scuff plate.

The deep-V shape and the reverse chines of the hull make the Cobalt ride smooth, solid and true with effortless total control.

In the ongoing exchanges between owners and builders, Cobalt has shown an entire industry exactly the way to go. For example, in what has become perhaps the most imitated component of runabout performance, the Cobalt extended running surface forces more of the hull into continuous, hugging contact with the water at cruising speeds. Meaning quicker planing, firm and true turns, minimized bow rise, and enhanced lift astern. Then the extended running surface combines with the other critical elements of the Cobalt hull – the deep, deep-V shape and the reversed chines most of all – to produce a design so nearly perfect that model year-to-model year changes are beside the point.

It was Cobalt who first built walk-thru transoms on smaller boats, Cobalt who devised the flip-lip seat, with all its flexible comfort, all its multitasked convenience, Cobalt who saw a way to build protection into necessarily vulnerable points of overall design – at the bow, for instance, where the now-legendary Cobalt scuff plate stands guard or at the windshield where a stainless steel latch beefs the hold in the open position.

As each Cobalt winds its way through the plant in Neodesha, the standards of the manufacturing process put into place the benefits of practical design. Spec'd as "the very best available," the raw materials of a Cobalt undergo testing and retesting, even as Statistical Process Control guarantees accu-



racy, efficiency, and economy across every step of the manufacture of boats working toward total customer satisfaction. Always, always though the individual Cobalt craftsman determines ultimate value. Daily, every Cobalt associate decides when a job has been done right.

And so it goes.

Day after day, more practical applications of imagination and ingenuity, more personal accountability, more hand craftsmanship, more conviction that – airplanes aside – all things are possible.





Beyond THE CONSTRUCTION

ere production can be very different from true productivity. At Cobalt we concern ourselves, first and last, with the quality as opposed to the quantity of our product. Nowhere is this Cobalt preoccupation with time spent on a job done right more obvious than in the laying of the hull, a process that we simply refuse to rush.



At Cobalt the hull means handiwork, with every layer rolled and rolled and rolled some more by craftspeople who believe that yet one more careful pass just can't hurt. And so the layers accumulate, eight altogether on the hull bottom and a full sixteen at the keel. Reinforced with Kevlar® and then strengthened again with

Spraycore®, the hull's structure hardens into the critical component of the legendary Cobalt ride, as another Cobalt hull emerges from molds maintained with NASA sorts of attention to tiny, tiny, barely begun imperfections.






Multiple layers of hand laid fiberglass woven roving and mat give the ultimate strength fiberglass parts.

At Cobalt, even in a process as intrinsically robotic as molding, craftsmanship plays its large part. The quality of the mold equals the quality of the finish, and so hand-waxing follows after every other part. Old finishes are reworked after every ten parts. No power buffers are allowed, and therefore no unsightly marks or patterns are left behind.

And because time in the mold ensures integrity, flexible strength, and year-to-year dependability, the long hours spent in the mold matter even more. Every Cobalt hull cures and cures a while longer – well beyond normal industry standards.

At Cobalt the materials of construction work with the methods of construction in the evolution of a hull imi-

tated every day in an industry unable to improve upon the Cobalt extended running surface. At the transom, for instance, next-generation technology has replaced every last ounce of wood, as all-composite construction – more than two inches thick – assumes all the loads and pressures, all the waterborne assault that a



transom must endure. Meanwhile the Cobalt transom isolates noise and vibration, its design and construction proven on every sunrise ski run, every evening's cruise to dinner.

And then, in the mating of the single-piece deck sidewall and floor with the hull, all the hand-craftsmanship, all the technology, all the time exceptionally well spent pay off in the creation of a Cobalt's stout heart. Here is structural soundness unmatched by any would-be competitor. Here is a boat built for thirty summers of hard, sun-filled, fun-filled use. Here, according to some little kids from southeast Kansas, is the best boat in the world.

The transom cut-out shows a core of structural composite that remains immune to rot for a lifetime.





Beyond A LIFETIME

obalt has always taken the long view.

Any manufacturer can point with pride to boats in their factory wrap, but Cobalt builds boats that, with just a little love and care, will look and perform like new after a couple of decades of family occasions. Take the helm of a teenaged Cobalt. Notice the fit and finish in place after seventeen summers. Smile at the faultless reflection in the gelcoat, smooth, lustrous,

its graphics still bold and distinct. Feel the deep-down luxury of the seats, supportive and supple, as intent on day-long comfort as on the day of their manufacture.


Cobalt boats age gracefully, age usefully because of the abiding strength of their construction No boat builder believes more than Cobalt in stainless steel and its application stem to stern. Stainless simply does not fade. It does not weaken, and so stainless steel is the structural material of choice in all Cobalt guhwhale, one-piece hand, and swim platform. Boarding ladders to latches to motorbox hinges, heavy-gauge stainless is solid and sure.




The strength and beauty of stainless steel engine vents for a lifetime of durability. No plastic here.

No wood to be found in the structural components of the Cobalt hull; a fiberglass stringer system, fiberglass motor mounts, and a composite transom.

Every cast fitting that passes through the hull is solid stainless, as are all the vents and scuff plates. And naturally, stainless does the job at points of high stress, at the windshield with its custome braces, for example, and in all supports for canvas.



Cobalt longevity is obvious, some of the reasons why less so. Invisible composites, hyperlight and hyperstrong, compose every Cobalt transom. No wood there, not in that all-important forcefield. No wood either in the polypropylene structural honeycomb of the floor. Nor in the all-fiberglass stringers where a methacrylate bonding compound adds lifelong permanence. No

wood in the water-impervious roto-cast seat bases.

Cobalt pioneered the use of metal backing plates

- under the seat bases, below all hardware and windshield mountings

- and over time some competitors have seen the wisdom of such pervasive reinforcement. But few, if any other manufacturers embed the backing in the fiberglass, a tradition that

Beyond THE INTERFACE

he technical word is "interface," those sensory exchanges between boat and owner, those points of contact so fundamental to the enjoyment of a day on the water, so critical to the determination of a boat's long-term value. Glance at any of the cockpit photography a few pages along, and witness the full effect of a Cobalt interior in the altogether. Better yet, cruise a Cobalt at first opportunity for some meaningful, memorable interfacing of your own.

panels. The instrumentation and its mountings borrow from aircraft and jewelry designers alike. Switching is sure, firm, and right there.



The elegant flow of line and precision stitchery in the side panels are rivaled only by their life-long composite structure and ergonomic design.



Fine upholstery over solid fiberglass structures, aluminum panels, real wood accents, and sealed stainless steel switches come together as one ultimate helm station.

The flip-lip seat, that grand old Cobalt invention now being copied here and there, introduces cockpit seating whose layout welcomes, whose firmness supports all day long, whose flexibility adapts to exactly who and




how many have come aboard. All Cobalt upholstery is now two-toned, bow to stern, every model – 202 to 323, and again this year Cobalt upholstery involves the fingers. Buttersoft and bullstrong, as tactile as they're easy on the eye, the vinyls here

are never expanded, always double-fastened with both glues and staples, and stitched with meticulous precision. Underfoot, the carpet is snap-down/snapout, rubber-backed, backed again with skip resistant noflex flooring under all, and heavy. Heavy far beyond any marine standard.

Fast forward now to Cobalt audio and video systems, to the music and movies waiting to make good afternoons more melodic, good evenings more dramatic. Six waterproof speakers position themselves strategically, aiming tunes to maximum entertainment effect; Sonys are standard, Kickers optional. Standard too are iPod® and MP3 ports, remote controls mounted at the helm and optionally at the transom, and – on some boats – DVD packages. For boaters really ready to rock, there are optional subwoofers, tower speakers with power amps, and the million or so musical and informational choices that are XM satellite radio.

Cobalt has covered the interfacial bases, it would seem, sufficient to the Cindy Hawley seal of approval. Straight, smooth, uniform, and very, very good looking.





Beyond The Engineering

ngineering anticipates. The engineer's job description asks that chance be predicted, that the effects of happenstance be eliminated or, at least, minimized. Cobalt engineers do not ask idly "What's the worst that could happen?" Cobalt designers understand that no boat is called a Cobalt until testing and more testing have proven its flawless operation. And so every Cobalt undergoes a full half-hour of running under maximum load in the test tank, with

well more than 30 checks of its systems completed. Boats are pulled at random from the production line for a trip to the lake for rigorous testing under real-world conditions; indeed, all boats 28 feet and larger are lake-tested.


In those components where experience has shown the critical importance of trouble-free performance, Cobalt brings extra attention to the details of design and installation. In the electrical system, most of all – where, as boaters know, little problems can quickly ruin a day on the water. Cobalt insists consequently on single runs in the wiring, with no splices, all harnesses made completely and expertly in-house, coded with those historic Cobalt colors.

All connectors attach mechanically, with quick disconnects at each component. All boats are wired for

those installed at the factory of course, and those to be added later. Batteries are switched for single or optional dual hookups.

The little details attended to, Cobalt performance then concerns itself with horsepower. Raw torque efficiently and economically used; brute force in the refined service of safety and direction and purpose. And so Cobalt owners choose from a weight-room overrun with Volvo Penta and MerCruiser sterndrive power, each fuel-injected, with major choices waiting in either single or dual prop drives, and more choices still with closed cooling systems. No choice whatsoever in the matter of warranty though: Cobalt protects the powertrain for five years, the manufacturer's promises extended until 2013 or so.

Every boat manufacturer pays major attention to the powerplant; Cobalt worries about the space surrounding. Engine compartments on a Cobalt are large, accessible, welcoming to owner and mechanic alike, with either gas-assist cylinders or power lifts waiting to let the sun shine in. All lighting necessary to engine inves-

tigation, maintenance, or repair has been built in. Storage areas come along at no extra charge, and the entire interior area has been finished to aircraft sorts of standards.

Fact is though, all the engineering in the world



cannot anticipate the rigors of the manufacturing day, any given morning's umpteen thousand little exchanges of premium raw materials with relentless hand craftsmanship, exchanges that honestly must go just so. And so when engineering isn't working at the moment, when anticipation a thousand-fold fails to answer a crisis, when a big Merc refuses to nestle quietly into a 303 on a late Thursday afternoon ... well ... that particular moment is when engineering takes a quick backseat to Tim Bohannon and six or eight other big old boys with about 45 minutes to make things turn out, you know, as calculated.





Beyond THE WARRANTY

ick Schoonover did not write the warranties that ensure Cobalt owners' ongoing satisfaction with their boats. Rick Schoonover does, however, work very hard to ensure that those warranties retain day to day their teeth. Rick takes care of Cobalt dealers, helping them obtain parts quickly and accurately, so that warrantied service and repairs proceed quickly and accurately.








Beyond Difficult Choices



Now, might a guy catch a little air?





And to ensure that the good times roll, just inside the lockable glovebox a Sony stereo head unit delivers the tunes through a standard iPod® (not included)/MP3 port.

Some morning very soon take the Cobalt 272 somewhere surprising.

With the longest list of optional equipment in the 2008 model line, the Cobalt 282 is amenable to any dress code you might have in mind.



ere comes the 303, a go-anywhere and do-anything amalgam of functionality and flat-out style, a watercraft for the undecided. For sure. The 303 is all things to all people,: a true dayboat ready for unforgettable exchanges of sunshine and moonlight. Meantime, the 303 brings along all the comforts, all the convenience appropriate to the best evenings away from home. Day and night, night or day, here's outer-spatial roominess; here are amenities central to the enjoyment of family and friends, to the thoughtful use of multiple cubic-feet imaginatively used bow to stern.

The room begins in the raising of the 303's deck, up a full four inches over its sister ship the 302, thereby multiplying walkabout in the cabin, ensuring easy access and comfortable use. "Entertaining" is a pivotal word in the 303's mission statement, and so the cockpit fans out from a hot-water sink and refrigerator with a built-in ice chest nearby. The 303's cabin stretches. Reaches way out. Out and away, up and around as your sixthree basketball son sits here with a full foot of headroom above. And, because of the thoughtful positioning of the galley, he may cook there standing straight up in the cockpit walk-thru. And all around him raw materials of consequence: cedar in the locker, fine-grain leather in the seats and rich fabric in the valances as, come bedtime, the 303 sleeps the point-guard and his brother in all-night comfort, the optional DVD flat screen dimming.

A rising moon confirming what we, each of us, already know: this boat does it all.
