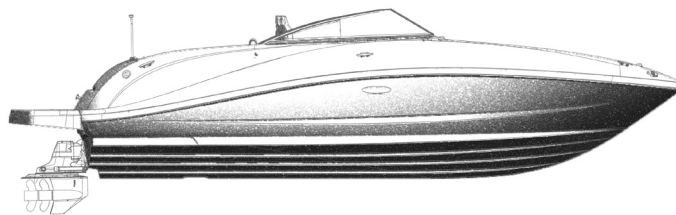

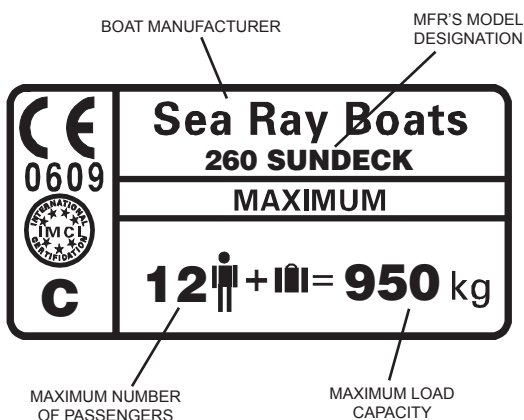

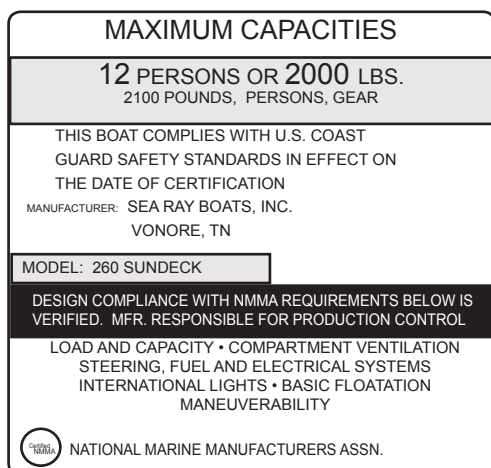
Never carry more weight or passengers than indicated on the certification plate, regardless of weather or water conditions.

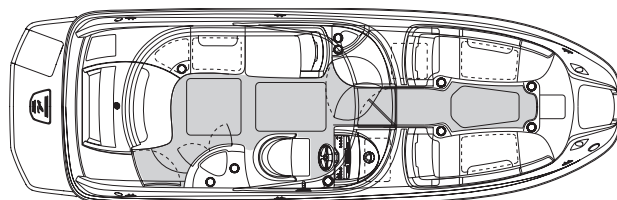
Wet decks are slippery.

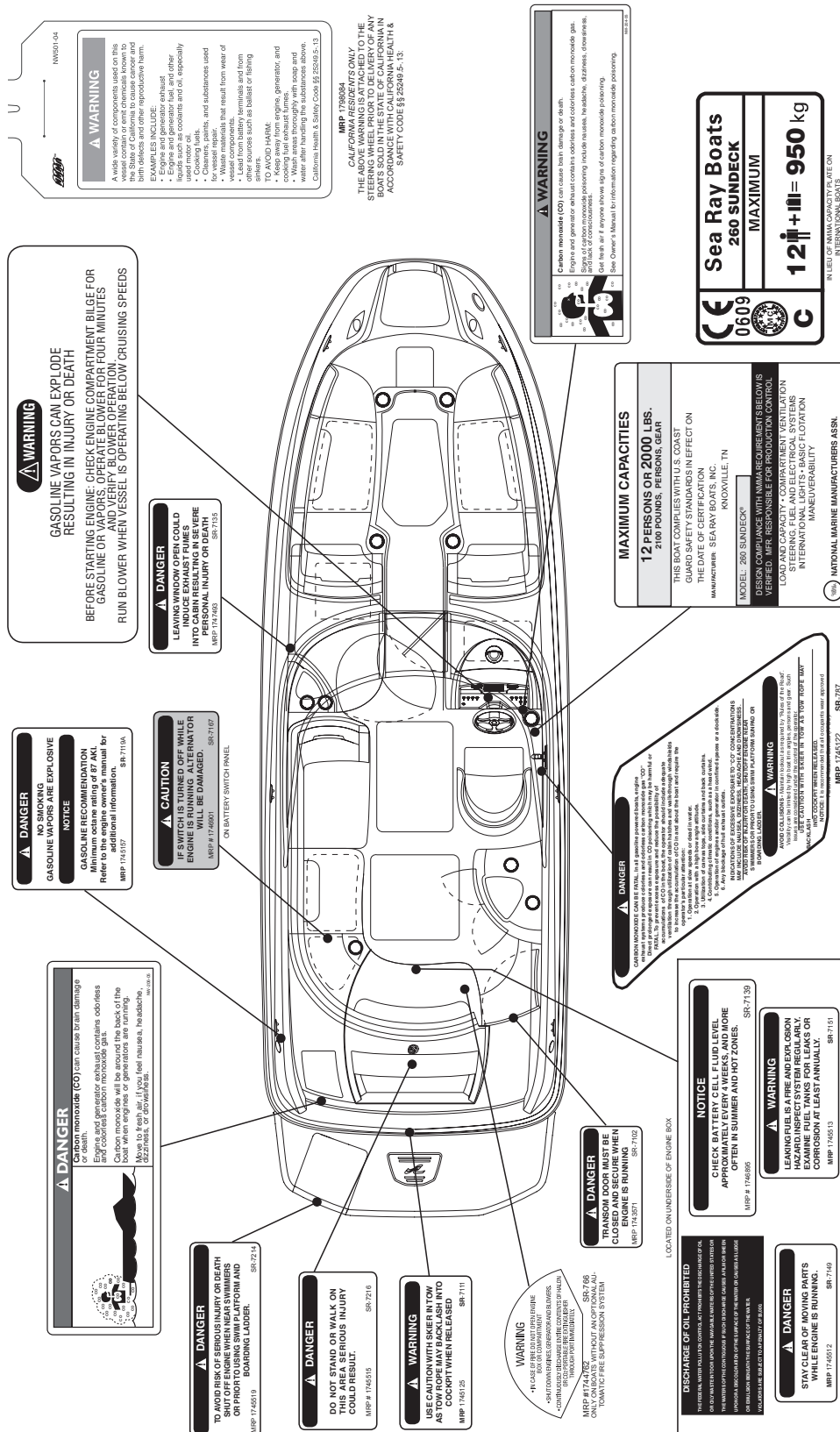

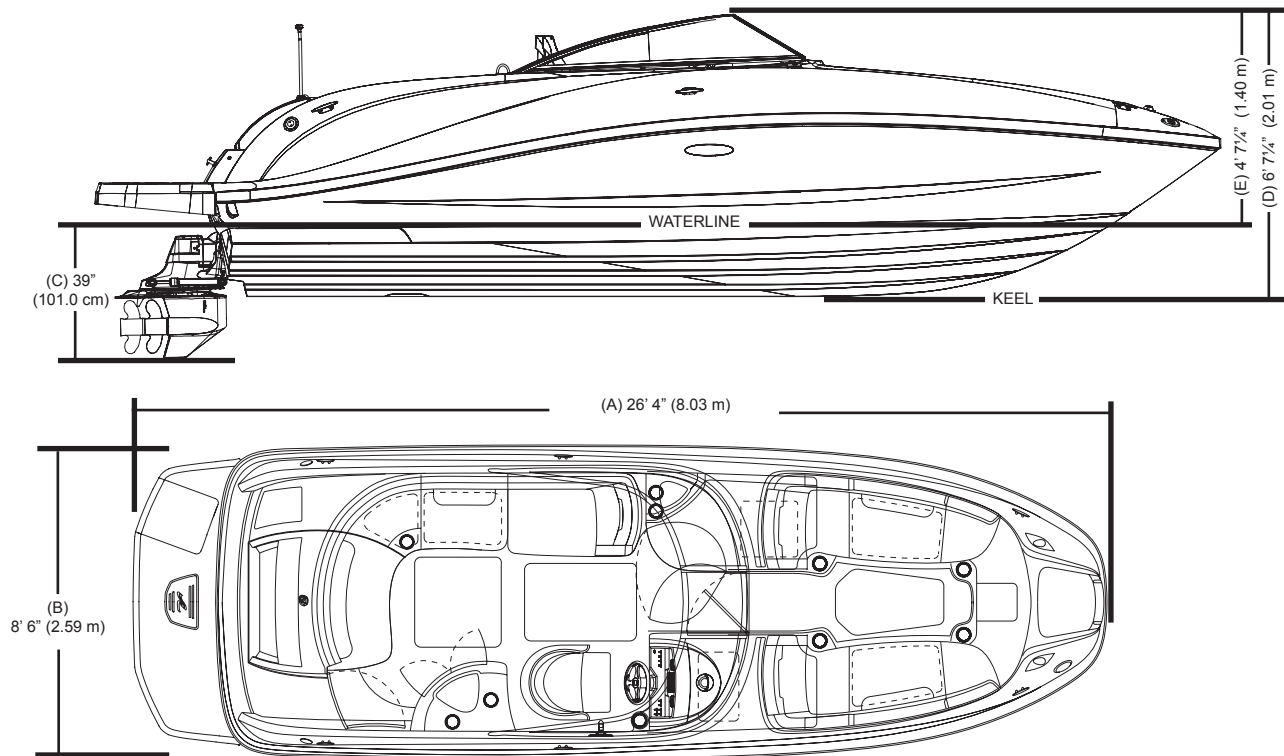

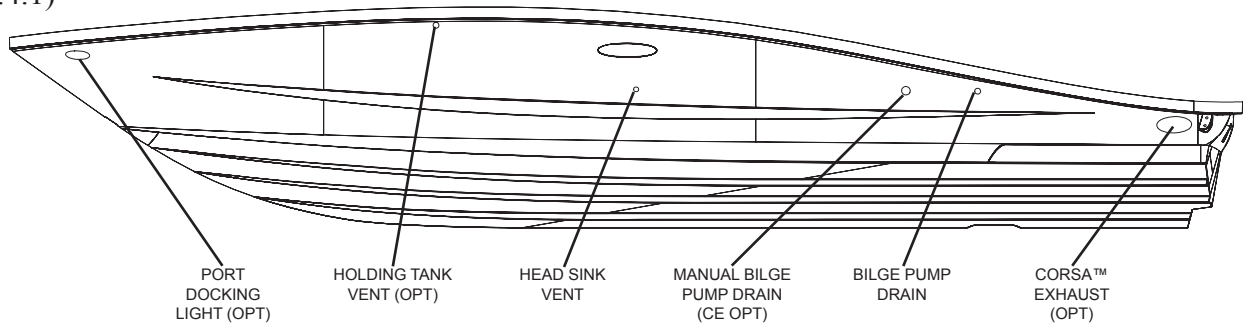

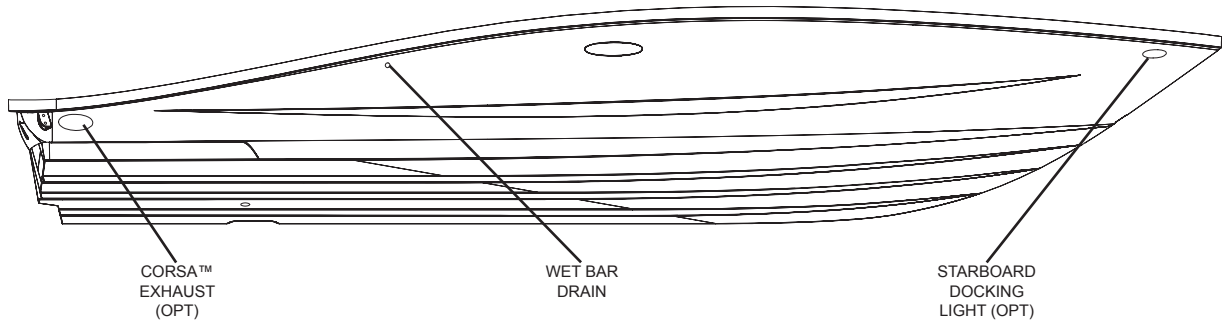

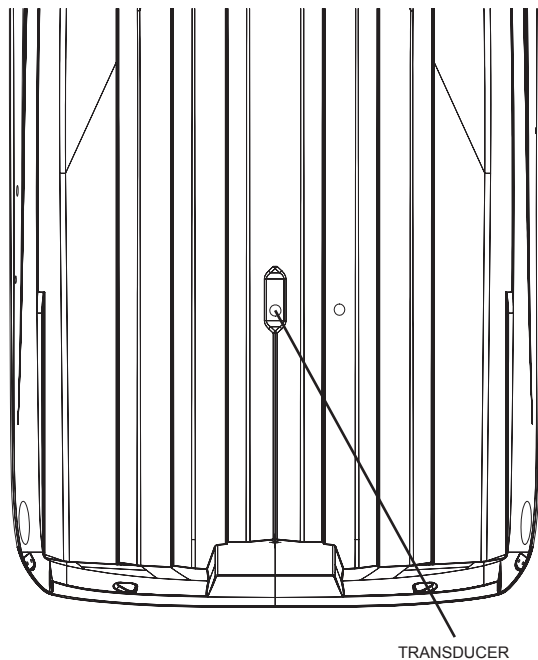
STARBOARD THROUGH-HULL CUTOUTS

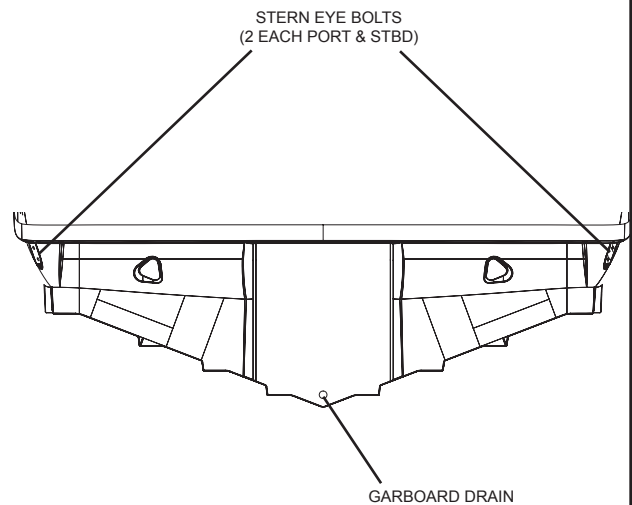
STARBOARD THROUGH-HULL CUTOUTS

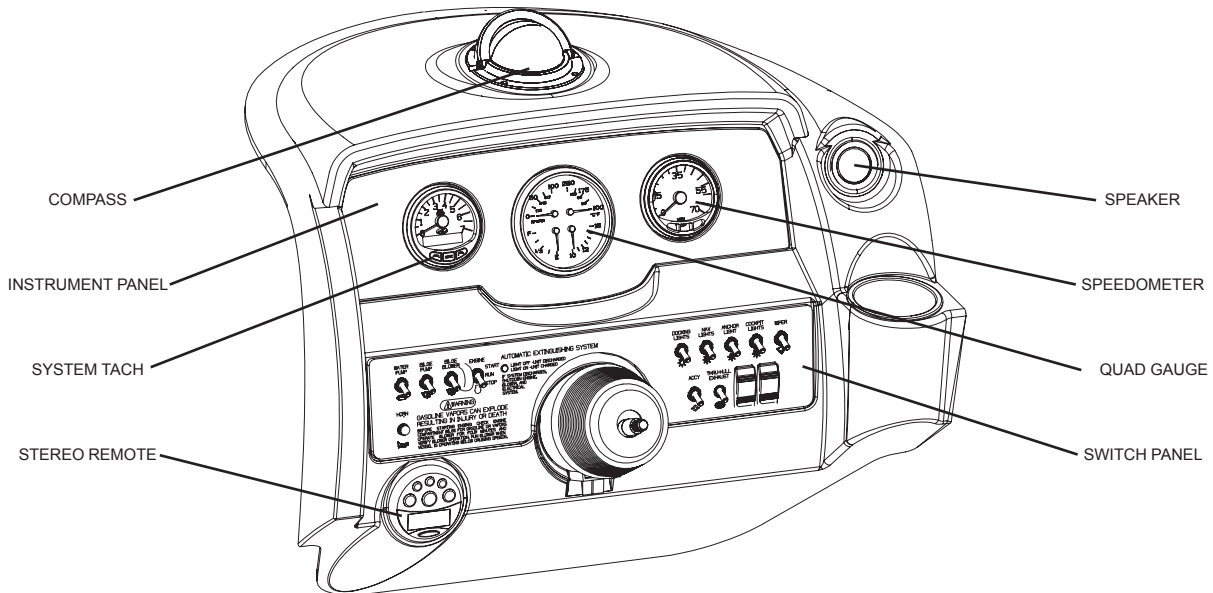
TRANSOM THROUGH-HULL CUTOUTS

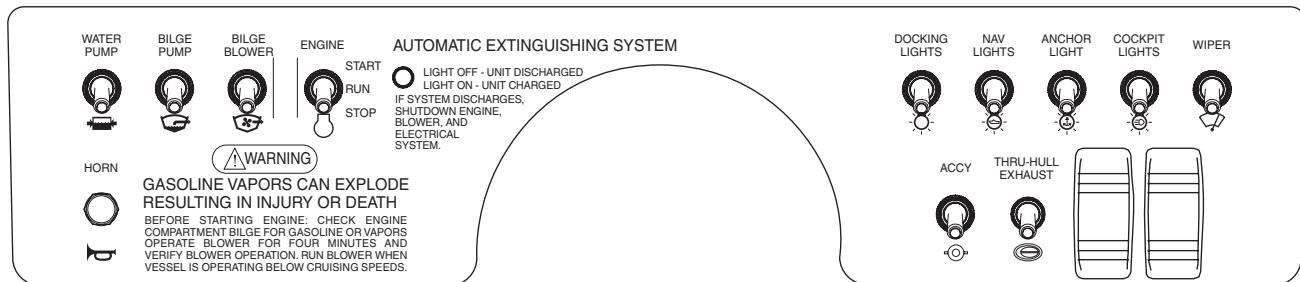

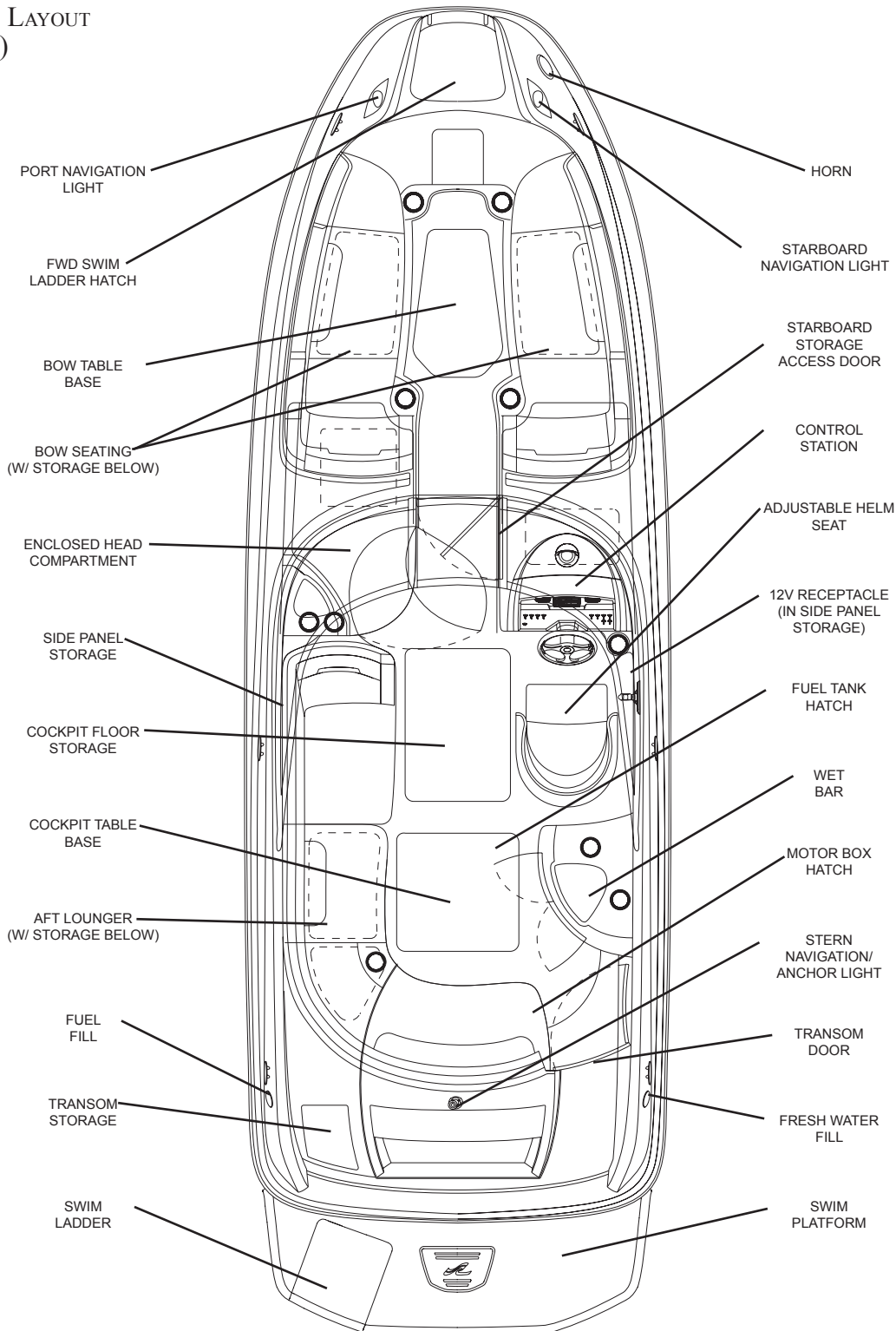
CONTROL STATION SWITCH PANEL

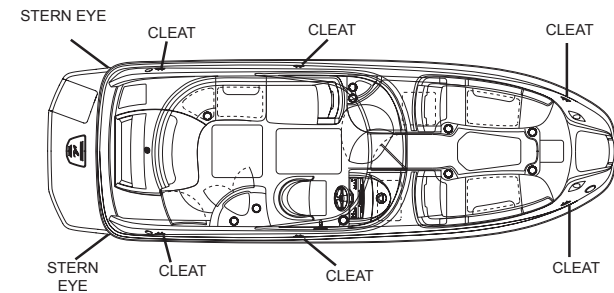


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8. CLEATS

Cleats must not be used for lifting the boat; they are intended for docking or mooring use only.

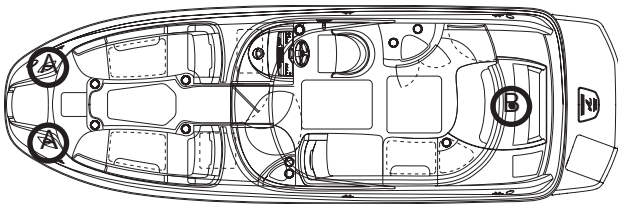

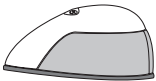

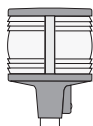

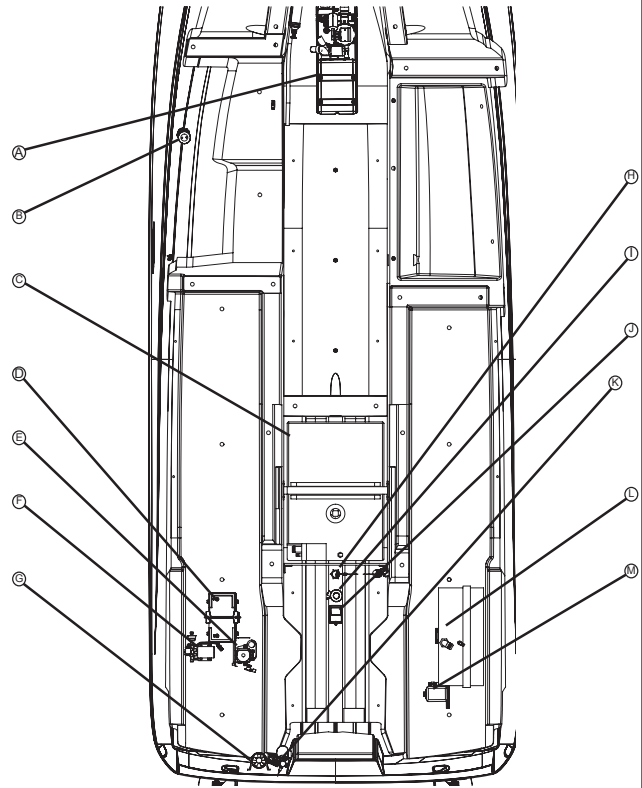

11. FIRE EXTINGUISHING SYSTEM

Your 260SD has an automatic fire extinguisher system option. Refer to the General Information Manual for a detailed explanation of the automatic fire extinguisher system.

12. FUEL SYSTEM

The 260 Sundeck standard gasoline fuel system consists of a 65 gallon (246.1 liter) fuel tank, fuel tank vent, anti-siphon valve, engine fuel supply line and fuel fill.

13. WATER SYSTEM

The fresh water system on the 260SD consists of a 20 gal. (75.7 liter) tank, 12v water pump, faucet (head compartment), sprayer (wet bar) and 2 pullout sprayers (bow and stern). Refer to the General Information Manual for a detailed explanation of the water system.

14. CANVAS

The following canvas pieces are available individually as options:

- Sunbrella® Bimini Top w/ Boot
- Cockpit and Tonneau Covers w/ storage Bag
- Travel/Storage Cover



DANGER

Exhaust fumes from engines contain deadly carbon monoxide gas (CO). Boats enclosed with canvas or with poor ventilation are most likely to collect fumes.

CO sickness symptoms include headache, nausea and dizziness. Do not mistake these symptoms for sea sickness.

Ventilate boat. See Section 1.4, Carbon Monoxide, for more details.

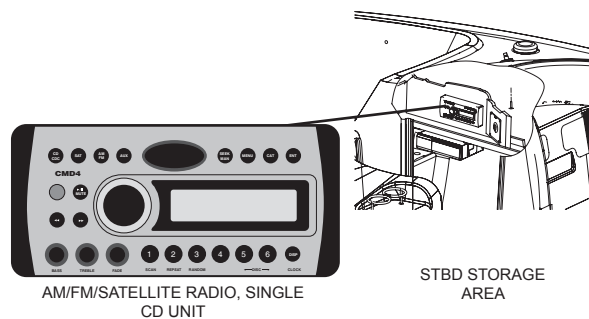
Do not use the rear (aft) curtain while engine is running or boat is moving.

15. ENTERTAINMENT SYSTEM

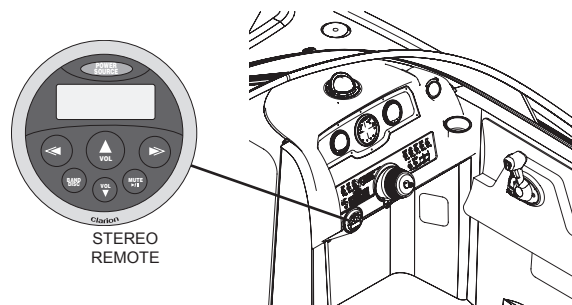
The 12 volt AM/FM radio single CD satellite ready stereo with MP3 port is located in the starboard storage area.

The system includes six (6) water proof speakers, a subwoofer, a digital remote control located at the control station and an optional remote on the transom. An optional speaker system is available with the Water Sports Tower option.

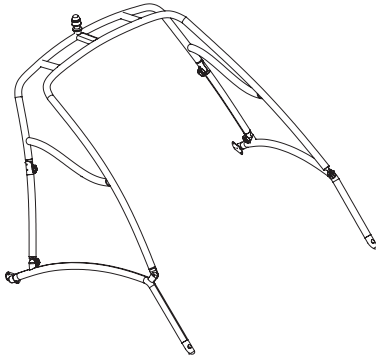

16. WATER SPORTS TOWER

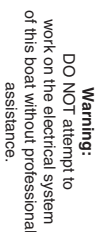
If equipped, the water sports tower provides a raised attach point (ski tow pylon) for the ski rope. The high attach point enables the skier to perform a wide variety of skills not capable with the lower transom attach point.

The tower attach point is intended for use only when towing a single skier. If you are towing multiple skiers or water toys carrying more than one person use only the transom attach point. The tower attach point is NOT intended for towing inflatables.

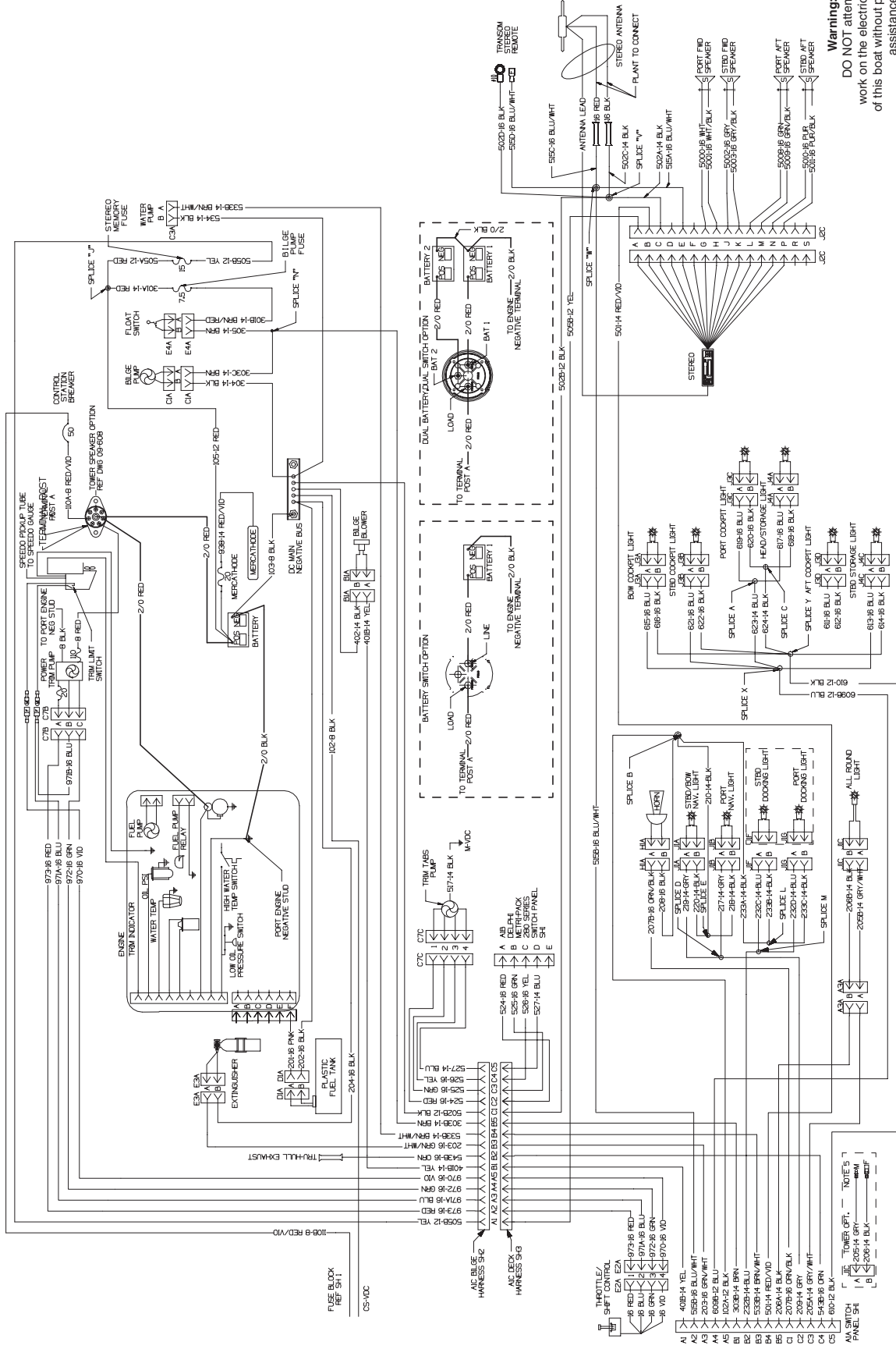
DC WIRING DIAGRAM (1 OF 3)

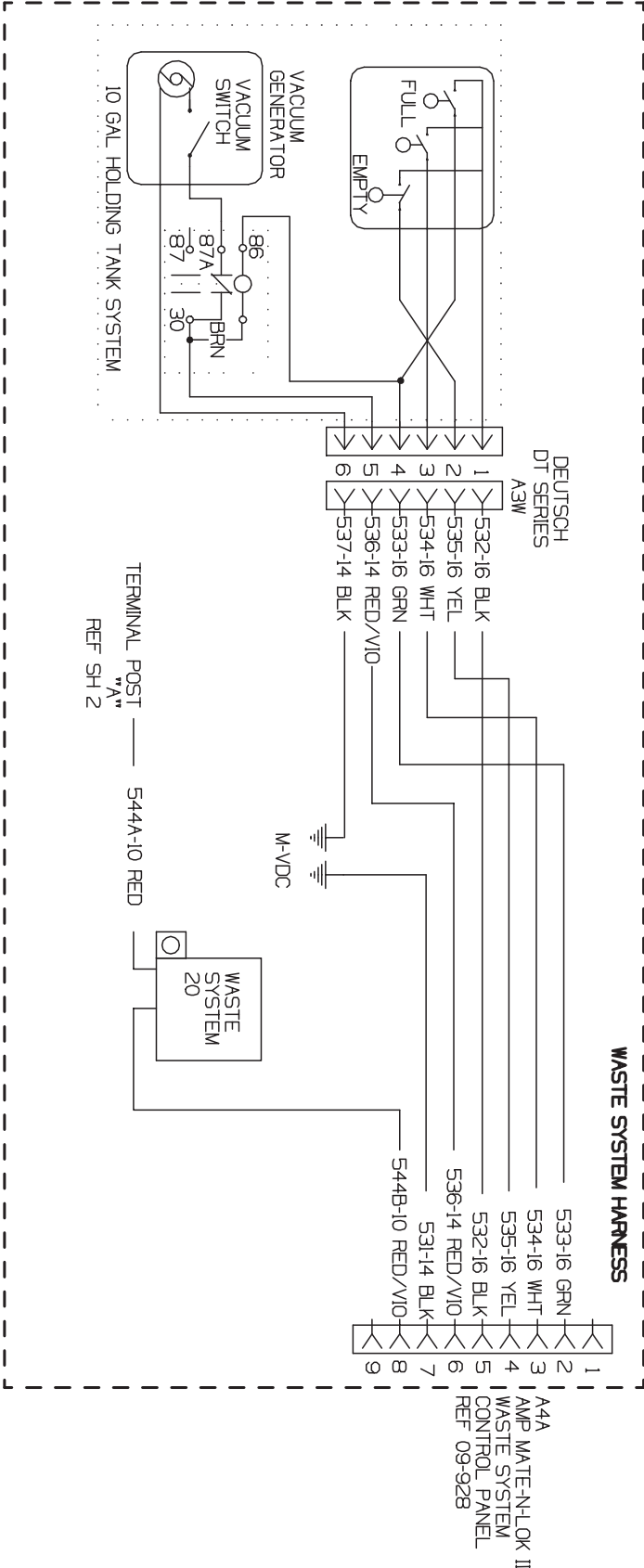
DC WIRING DIAGRAM (2 OF 3)

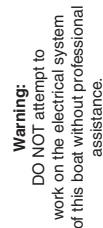

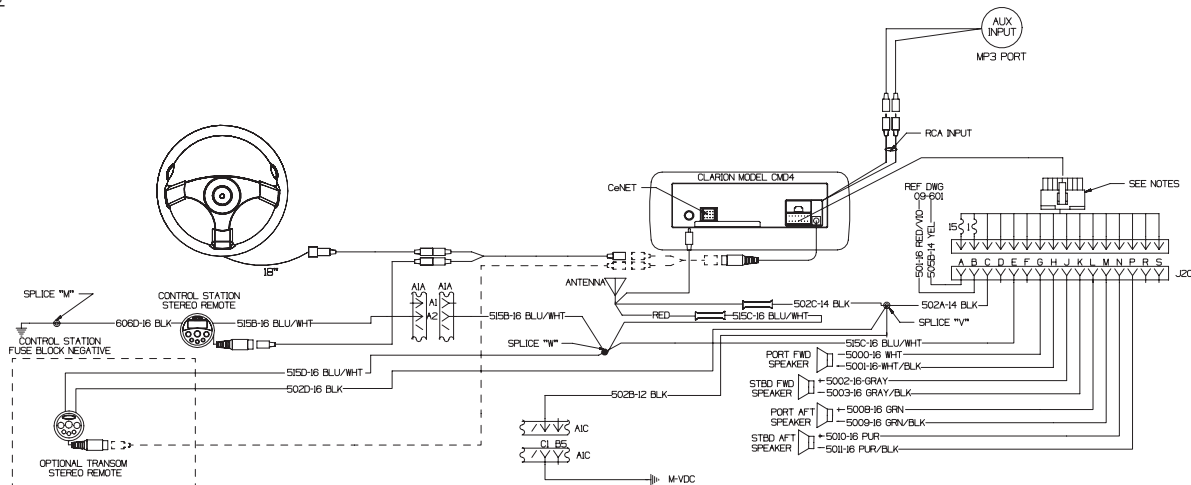
DC WIRING DIAGRAM (MERC DTS OPTION)

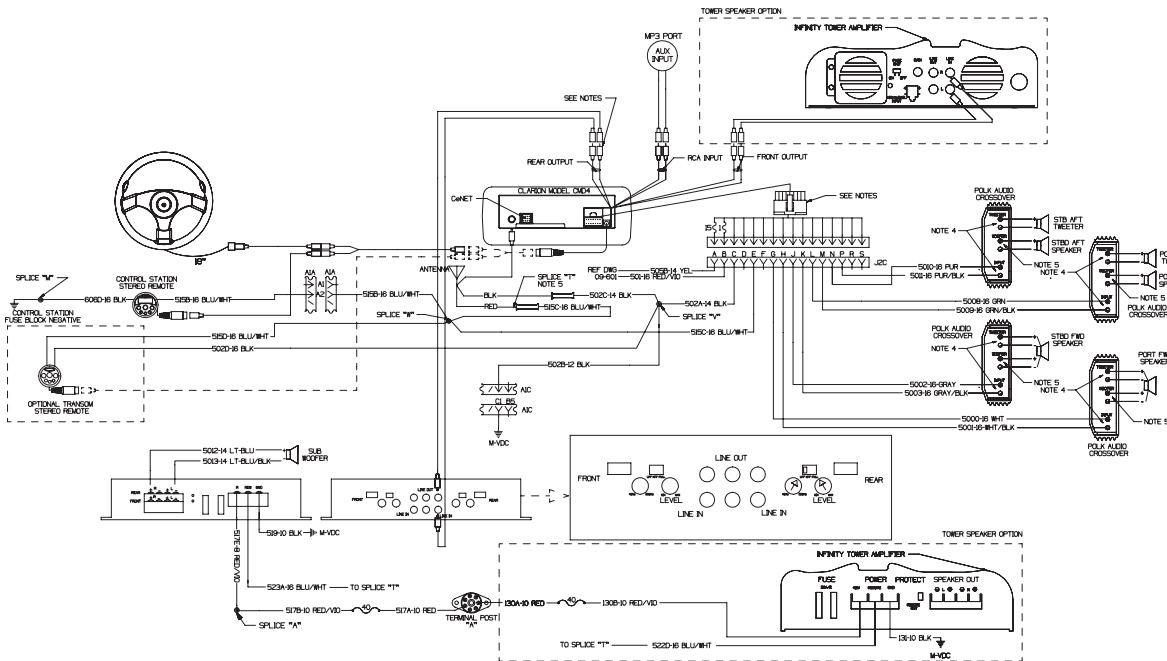

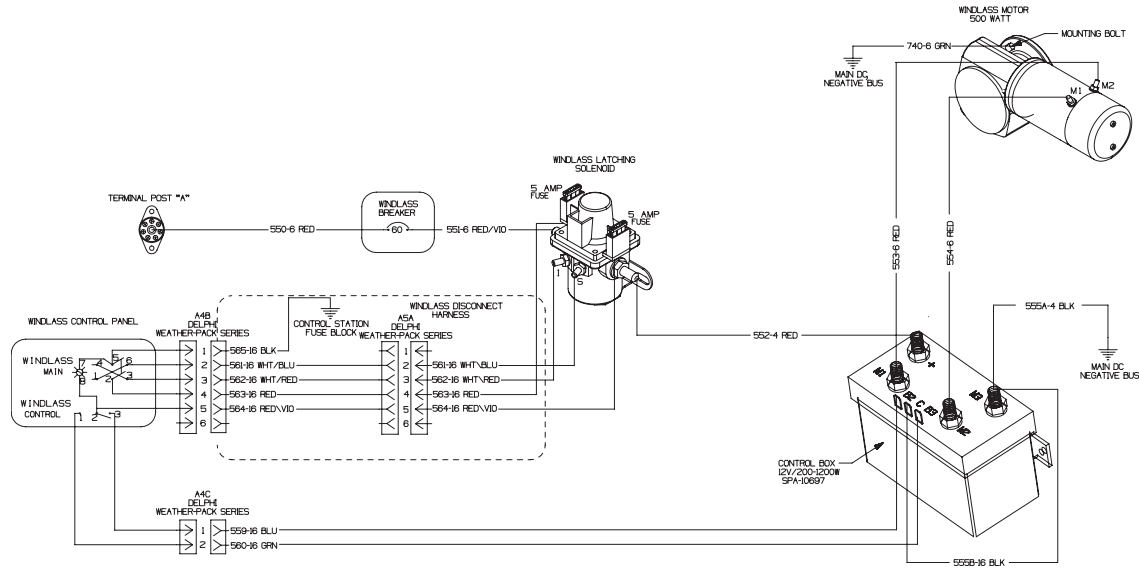
STEREO WIRING DIAGRAM (OPTIONAL)

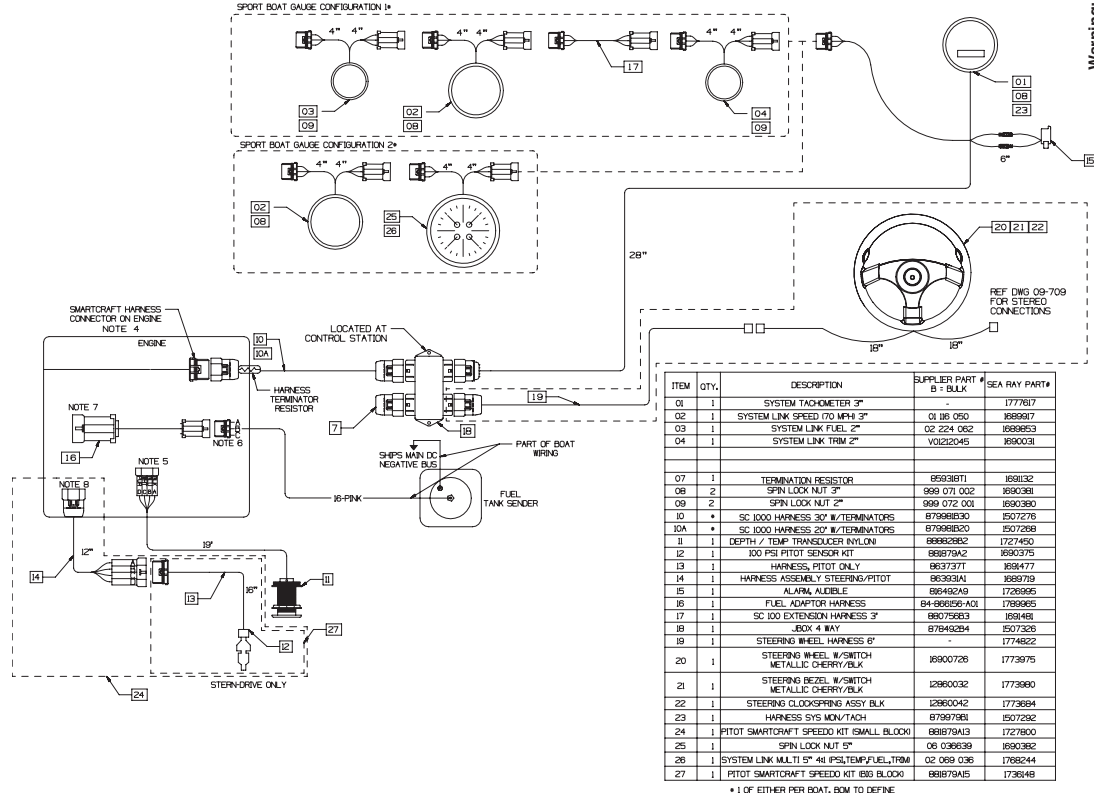
WINDLASS WIRING DIAGRAM

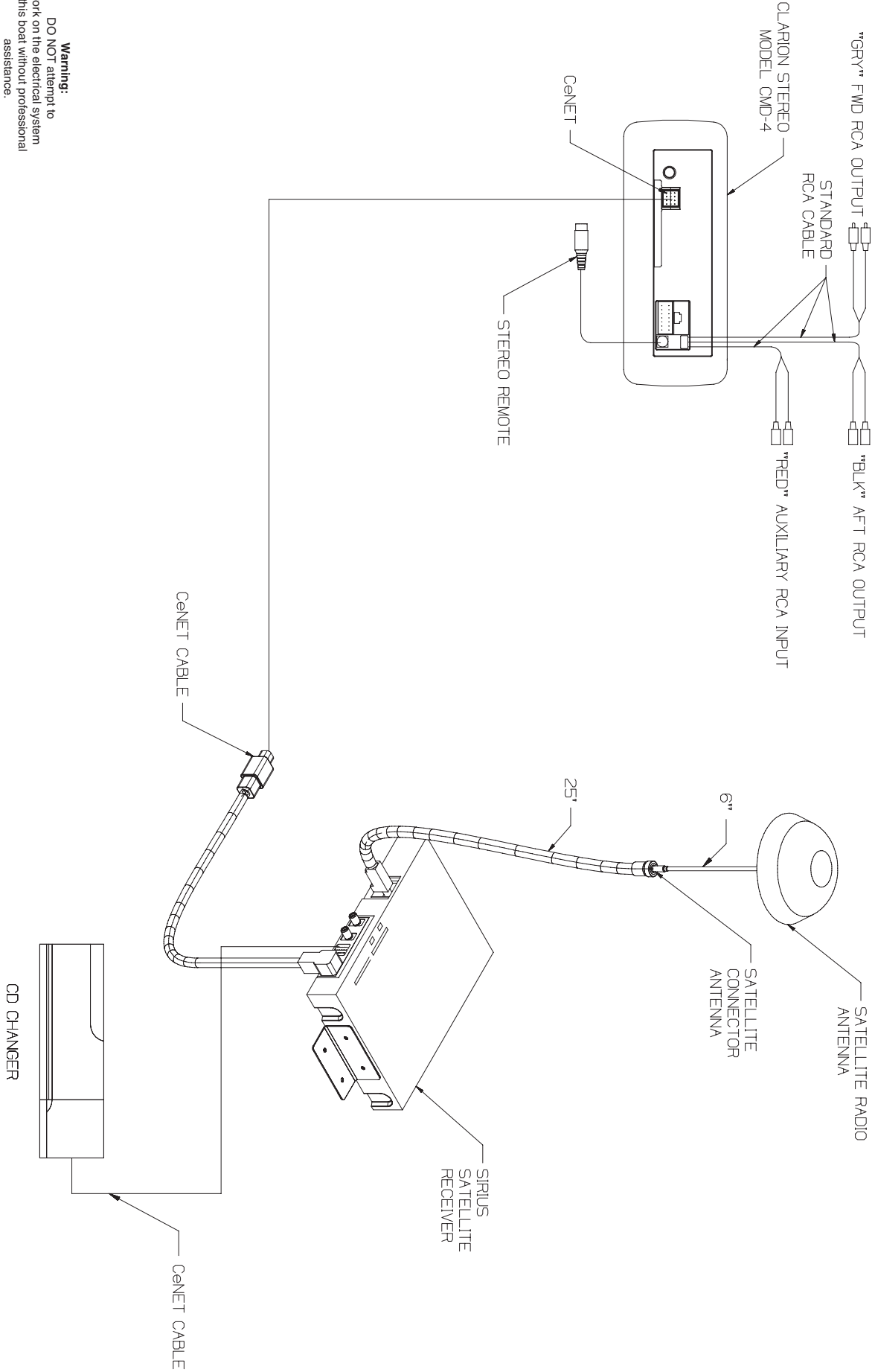

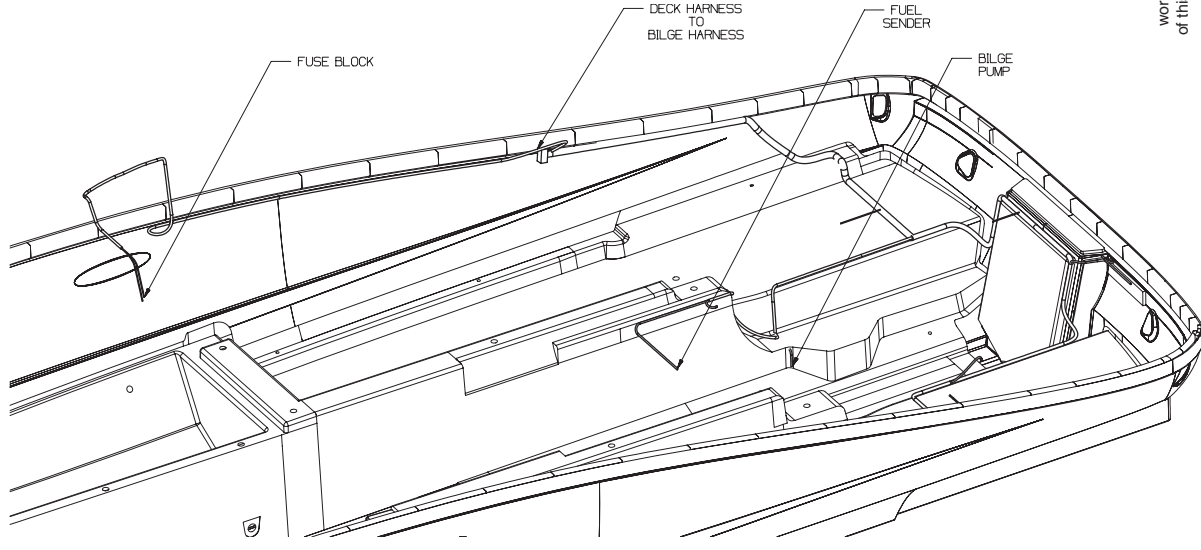

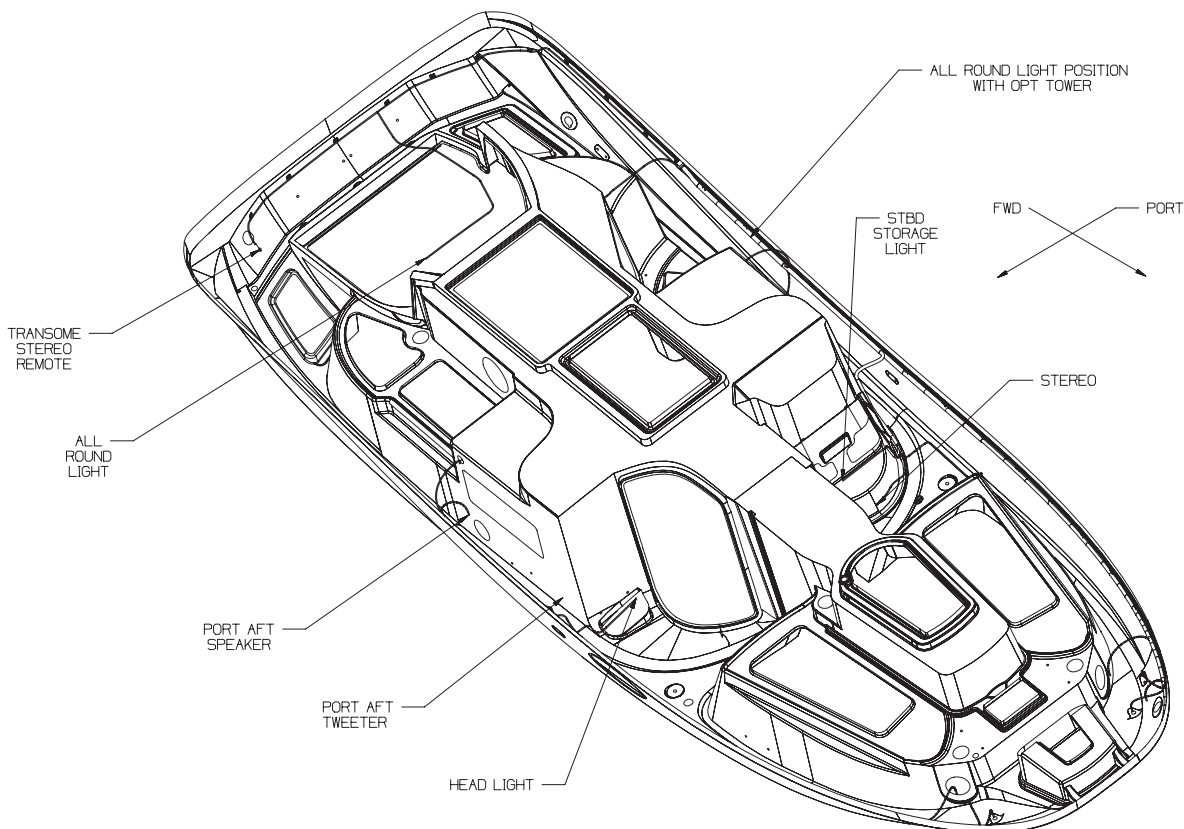

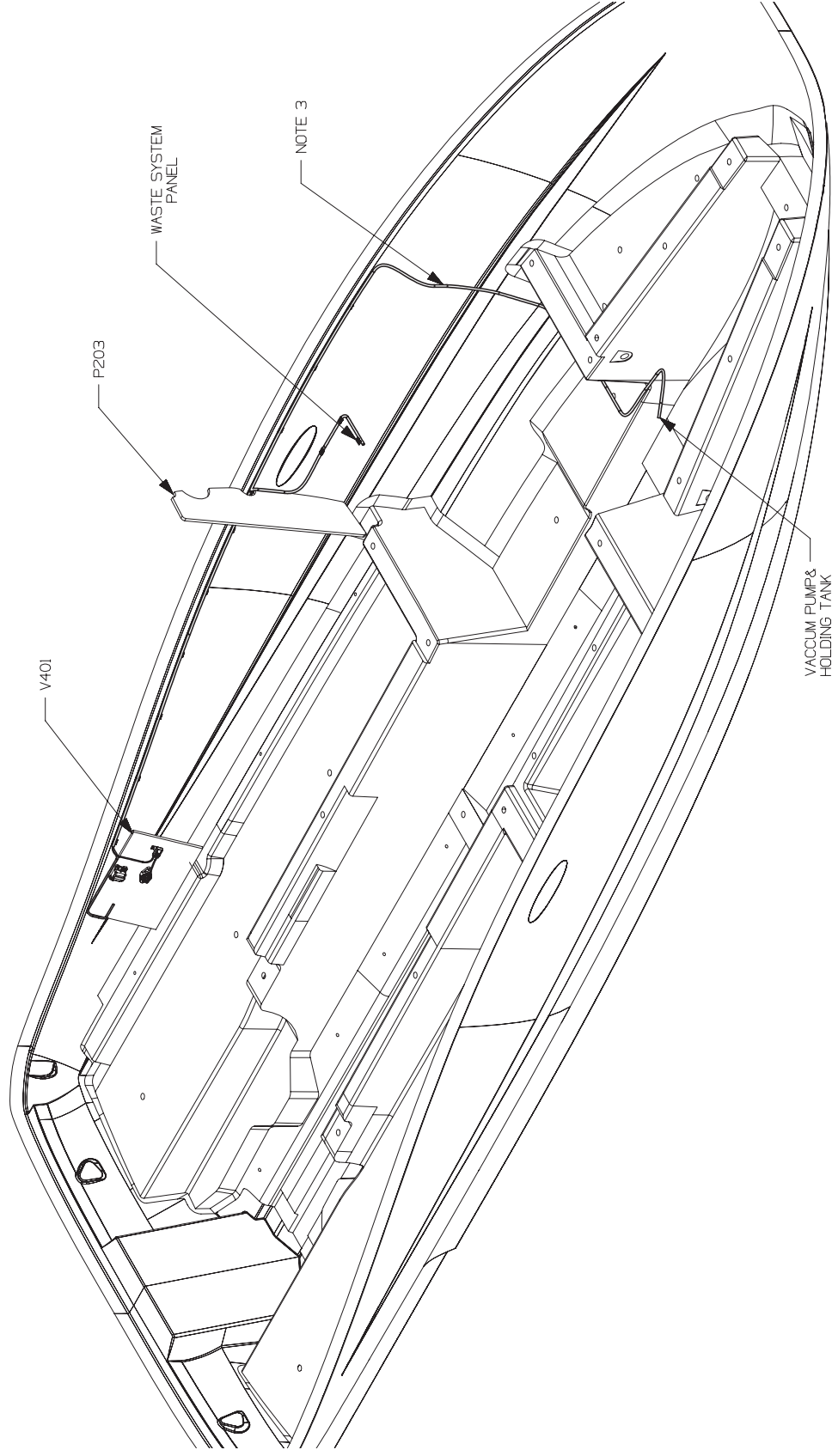
BILGE HARNNESS
